
REPEAT COURSES POLICY

Pathways Academy Adult Education (“PAAE” or the “Charter School”) adopts this Repeated Courses Policy to apply to students enrolled in the Charter School.

In alignment with PAAE’s educational strategy of promoting repetition and mastery of material, students are permitted to repeat courses. When a course is repeated:

- The original course and grade remain on the transcript; however, the credits for the original course are recorded as zero, and the original grade is excluded from the GPA calculation.
- The repeated course appears on the transcript with an “R” to indicate it is a repeat.
- Credits and GPA points are applied to the repeated course and its corresponding grade.

The procedures described in this policy are used to calculate the PAAE official GPA for students. For students applying for college admission, financial aid and/or scholarships programs, such colleges and programs may use a calculation or criteria to determine eligibility and GPA that is different from the calculation described in this policy for PAAE’s official GPA. In such instances, the PAAE official GPA may not be applicable for such colleges and/or programs.
